Address for Sat Nav: EN11 9BU By Road from London

- Take the A10 north (M25 Jnc 25) and leave at the signposted Hoddesdon junction after 5.5 miles
- At the top of the slip road turn right, which takes you onto the A10 link road
- At the bottom of the hill, turn left at the first roundabout into Amwell Street
- Turn left at the next roundabout (after 100 yards) into Hertford Road (B1179)
